

Pewaukee Parks & Rec receives \$250K sponsorship for splash pad

CITY OF PEWAUKEE — The Parks & Recreation Office announced they received a \$250,000 naming rights sponsorship for the future splash pad coming to the Pewaukee Sports Complex.

The donation comes from Rick Fuhry, with the splash pad to be named “Garrison’s Splash Pad” after Fuhry’s nephew.

“We are so grateful and look forward to making the rest of this project a reality!” the department said in a statement.

Children of all abilities will be able to use both the all-inclusive playground and splash pad.

The estimated project cost is \$1.5 million and the City of Pewaukee has committed more than \$4 million for the land and development of the Pewaukee Sports Complex.
